

The arrival of a new tenant brings them together and allows them to share their true selves.

In alternating chapters, Rene and Paloma share their sometimes funny, often heartbreaking stories and discourse on topics ranging from politics to Kant to Anna Karenina. Their friendship at the end brings the novel to a moving conclusion.
