The Postmistress

American radio reporter Frankie Bard is broadcasting news out of London alongside Edward R. Murrow in 1940. Desperate for her countrymen to understand the grim reality of the war in Europe, Frankie embarks on a dangerous train ride across Europe, meeting Jews who are trying to escape and recording their voices, while they are still alive. Meanwhile, in coastal Franklin, Massachusetts, resides Iris James, the town's postmistress. Iris secretly possesses a letter written to Emma Fitch from her husband Will, the local young doctor who has taken himself off to London to offer his medical skills despite Emma's protests.

This debut novel is nearly impossible to put down. Filled with powerful descriptions of wartime Europe, this page-turner will stay with you long after you close its cover.

The Lock Artist

As an 8-year-old, Mike, aka Miracle Boy, witnessed a traumatic event that caused him to stop speaking. Now, as he serves his last year in prison, he narrates his journey from promising young artist to expert lock picker, eventually revealing the event that started it all.

This psychological thriller is a perfect mix of character, suspense and story. Hamilton writes with empathy and page turning gusto.

Watchlist: A Serial Novel

War crimes investigator Harold Middleton is featured in two serial novellas. In ***The Chopin Manuscript***, Harold learns of an unknown Chopin study that includes a secret code that has world-wide implications. In ***The Copper Bracelet***, Harold becomes involved in a plot that could send India and Pakistan to the brink of nuclear war.

Jeffrey Deaver sets the plot in motion and guest authors each write a chapter. These two entertaining, fast-paced stories take on a life of their own.

So Cold the River

Eric Shaw is a promising young filmmaker whose been kicked to the curb by Hollywood and now making life-story films for funerals. When he's asked to do a documentary of 95-year-old Campbell Bradford, by Bradford's daughter-in-law, it's an offer he can't refuse. She gives him a mysterious old, green bottle of "Pluto Water" from a mineral spring in Bradford's home town in Southern Indiana where grand hotels hosted the wealthy and famous in the roaring 20s. But, when he gets there, the only Campbell Bradford he can find record of would have to be over 120-years-old!
