

From January 2 through February 15, the Library is running a special program to reduce your fines. This is your opportunity to settle your account completely by paying half the fines you owe.

- Clear your account by paying your fines in cash, OR
- You can opt to donate canned food items to benefit the Rocky River Assistance Program.
- You must select one or the other option and bring your account to a zero balance to take advantage of this offer.
- For every non-perishable item you donate, we will reduce your fine by \$1.00.
- This offer is available one time only, per patron, during this period.
- Please bring your food donations to an associate in the Circulation Department when you are ready to completely settle your account.
- This discount does not apply to payments that were made prior to January 2.

The 50% discount applies only to fines and fees owed the Library. It will apply to accounts already turned over to a collection agency. As a result, patrons can clear their account for half the amount owed. Please be advised that the Library is unable to repair or change a credit report. This discount does not apply to checks returned for insufficient funds.

*Preferred canned food items are fruits, beef stew, chili and vegetables.*



**Fines Increase**  
**Effective February 16**

At the end of this special program, fines will change effective February 16. To stay in line with other libraries, RRPL will increase fines for overdue materials from 5 cents to 10 cents per item per day for all items, except \$1.00 per day for In-Demand DVDs and QuickFlick DVDs. This will be our first fine increase in over 10 years.
