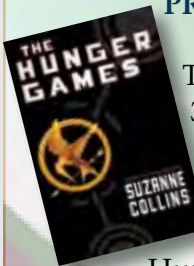

THE COWAN POTTERY MUSEUM ASSOCIATES

Both the Library and the CPMA,
the Museum's affiliate group, will
be playing major roles in the Cowan
Pottery Centennial 2012-2013.
The Cowan Associates, ever since
its founding in 1997, has sup-
ported the Museum by donating
pieces to the collection, by raising
money for the museum's preser-
vation and acquisition fund and by
promoting Cowan Pottery.

In addition, the Associates also
fund the annual R. Guy Cowan
Scholarship for advanced ceram-
ics students from the Cleveland
Institute of Art, where R. Guy Cowan
taught. The Associates' contri-
butions to the Museum have
been phenomenal. One member
alone has given 107 pieces to the
Museum over the past 15 years.
In 2011, either individual mem-
bers or the CPMA as a group have
donated 33 pieces to the Museum
for a total value of \$13,555.00! In
2008, the CPMA and the Library's
Board of Trustees made possible
the extensive renovation of the
Egyptian Maidens tile mural that
hangs near the Library's entrance.

The CPMA has enhanced both
the Museum and the Library,
and contributed to their unique-
